He wana kēia, he i'a wanawana

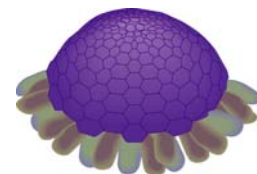
This is a sea urchine, a spiny sea creature
